For a successful presentation, please follow these simple guidelines:

- A good font to use is Arial with a 26 point size and 1.5 line spacing.
- Avoid using *Italics* and too many words per screen.
- On a white background, use a dark color for example: navy, wine, brown or black.
- On a dark background, use a light color (white or yellow).
- If using color, make certain your work can also be read if printed in B&W.
- Equations: typed is not recommended, but using an Equation Editor is because the equations are then embedded as a graphics object.
- Cutting and pasting from other source documents = potential disaster with unrecognizable character generation going from computer to computer.

- Rehearse the presentation yourself completely, especially animation, and especially if someone else prepared it for you.
